Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfector of faith.

— Hebrews 12:1-2a

I don't think any of us would be here without that "great cloud of witnesses." We so need each other to "run with perseverance the race marked out for us." I would not have received the gift of being part of a family of faith without all the others who were part of my home church.

In my mind, my own family had to show up for me, but none of the rest of the people at church did. Yet, throughout my life, many of them were there every week. Some I grew up with in Sunday school and youth group. Others I saw singing in the choir, reading scripture and leading in worship. Some set up coffee and treats for fellowship time. Some organized mission projects and got us all involved in them. Some led Bible studies or arranged for special church events. They all taught me, with mostly their actions, the gift of being part of Christ's Body.

But I learned about far more than just doing from them. I learned who Christ calls us all to be from how they participated and interacted with each other. It wasn't that they never disagreed, but it was how they handled each other in the midst of those disagreements that taught me the power of love. They didn't cancel or cut each other off. Over time they worked through whatever came up. They weren't all best friends—yet even those with clashing personalities showed up at funerals, setting up the sanctuary or the reception or the lunch. They sat together at Bible studies and worked together on mission projects. As they kept showing up over the years, I watched some of their rough edges gradually smooth and disagreements shift to an acceptance of different perspectives and a sense that we are all in this life together.

Because Allhallowstide opens the month of November—that's the days of Halloween, All Saints Day and All Souls Day—it becomes an opportunity to remember and give thanks for those we've known in that great cloud of witnesses who have shown us how to live Christ's way. As you make your way from Allhallowstide to Thanksgiving, I invite you take a moment each day to remember and give thanks for those whose faith has shaped your life. In doing so, you will see God's incredible grace made plain in the great treasure of faith we have in each other.

SCAM-alot and Council Highlights!

As Pastor Melinda described in her newsletter article for October, the UCSJ family has been the victim of email and texting scams trying to use Pastor Melinda to raise money. With Artificial Intelligence (AI), people can now pretend to be someone in phone calls and videos. Scams are everywhere and UCSJ is not exempt.



The Administrative Committee of the Council is taking several steps to minimize those scams going forward. Please be patient as we go through those processes.

- We have asked that electronic distribution of the church directory be suspended for the time being.
- We are going to work with our insurer to see what protections they would suggest.
- We will review the security of our computer and internet systems at the church to discover any weaknesses we might have so we can reduce those.

Even with these precautions, there is only one person who can assure your safety from scams—YOU. Over the next few months, UCSJ will try to provide education opportunities, warnings and assistance in dealing with these attacks. Your banking institutions and organizations like AARP continue to provide scam warnings. Pay attention to them. We've had reports of major retailers giving warnings when people tried to purchase multiple gift cards (one of the scams that hit UCSJ).

It's tempting to just say "Don't trust anybody," but that seems a terrible way to live. Maybe the best admonition is, "Trust, but verify." Pastor Melinda has already indicated that she won't solicit your help by emails or texts. If you receive a request that seems out-of-the-ordinary, ask before you do anything. If you get an email you don't recognize, don't click on attachments or links in the email. If your bank asks for information, call them or better yet, go in and talk to someone in person.

If it sounds unusual or too good to be true, be skeptical. Protect yourself and be safe.

For over 50 years, we have joined together as Lutherans through <u>ELCA World Hunger</u> to address the root causes of hunger and poverty and to foster sustainable solutions in more than 60 countries around the world.

United Church of Christ — What made Kimmel's dismissal particularly alarming to the <u>United Church of Christ's Media Justice Ministry</u> were threats that the current chairman of the <u>Federal Communications Commission (FCC)</u> made right before Kimmel's firing and comments he made about freedom of speech and <u>broadcasting "in the public interest."</u>
